

BOOK REVIEWS, ESSAYS, AND SCIENCE REPORTS

I. Book Reviews, Essays, and Science Reports

1. **Book Reviews:** Book reviews should be shorter than 1000 words in length and provide all relevant information about the book under review including author, editors, publisher, price, and year of publication. We will accept book reviews on titles that cover a broad range of areas from science to policy. **Requires:** Title Page
2. **Essays:** Essays should be shorter than 1000 words and do not require references. These are creative pieces. Essays may discuss topics such as personal experiences, views on healthcare, perspectives on research, etc. Creative stories are encouraged, as well as science fiction stories dealing with the implications of health technology, bioethics, policy, etc. **Requires:** Title Page
3. **Science Reports:** Science Reports should not exceed 3000 words and should describe the scientific implications and basis of new health, ethics, and policy developments, review or address the latest research in fields, etc. An example report would be a review of DNA testing technology for HPV in place of the Pap smear and the science behind the procedure as well as the implications. If you wish to submit basic science or clinical research, please consult with the editorial board ahead of time. **Requires:** Title Page, Abstract, References

II. Requirement Descriptions

1. **Abstract and Title Page:** The abstract should no exceed 250 words. The title page should include the title of the work, the names of all authors, the affiliations of all authors (university or institution, year of study or position, major or degrees, supporting professors), and an email address at which the author or authors may be readily contacted.
2. **Citations:** All major academic reference styles are accepted for submissions. It is the author's responsibility to ensure that references are accurate and up to date. The Editorial Board reviews and investigates the sources for all submissions. Papers must be referenced and cited using a numerical style of citation, with each reference bearing a numeral corresponding to first appearance within the paper and using the same numerical citation for each use of the reference thereafter. *Please use in-text citations and not the built in word processor citation system.* For example:

“...we can say that according to X... (1) The theories of Y, however, prove. (2)” The Editorial Board reviews and investigates the sources for all submissions.

II. Submitting the Book Review, Essay, or Science Report

1. **Deadlines:** TuftScope does not extend submission deadlines, except in rare circumstances. We request that authors contact *TuftScope* if circumstances prevent submission on time.
2. **Publication Consent:** All authors must submit the *Consent of Publication Form* for all submissions. The *Consent of Publication Form* may either be mailed to TuftScope or it may be scanned into the computer and sent electronically. The form may be sent after the submission is sent.
3. **Submission Format:** Submissions must be sent as Microsoft Office files (.doc) or in another accessible format. Please label the attachment as “LastName_TuftScope_Submission.” For example, “Smith_TuftScope_Submission.” Do not send submissions in formats that cannot be edited (.PDF). When the submission is received a receipt will be generated containing information regarding the submission.
4. **Submitting Documents:** Submissions should be sent to TuftScope@gmail.com or uploaded to the www.tuftscopejournal.org submissions system.
5. **Editing:** If the submission is accepted for publication, the Editorial Staff may contact the author(s) of the submission regarding potential changes or issues in the submission that may need to be addressed prior to publication. The Editorial Board requests that authors respond in a timely manner to such inquiries to facilitate the publication process.
